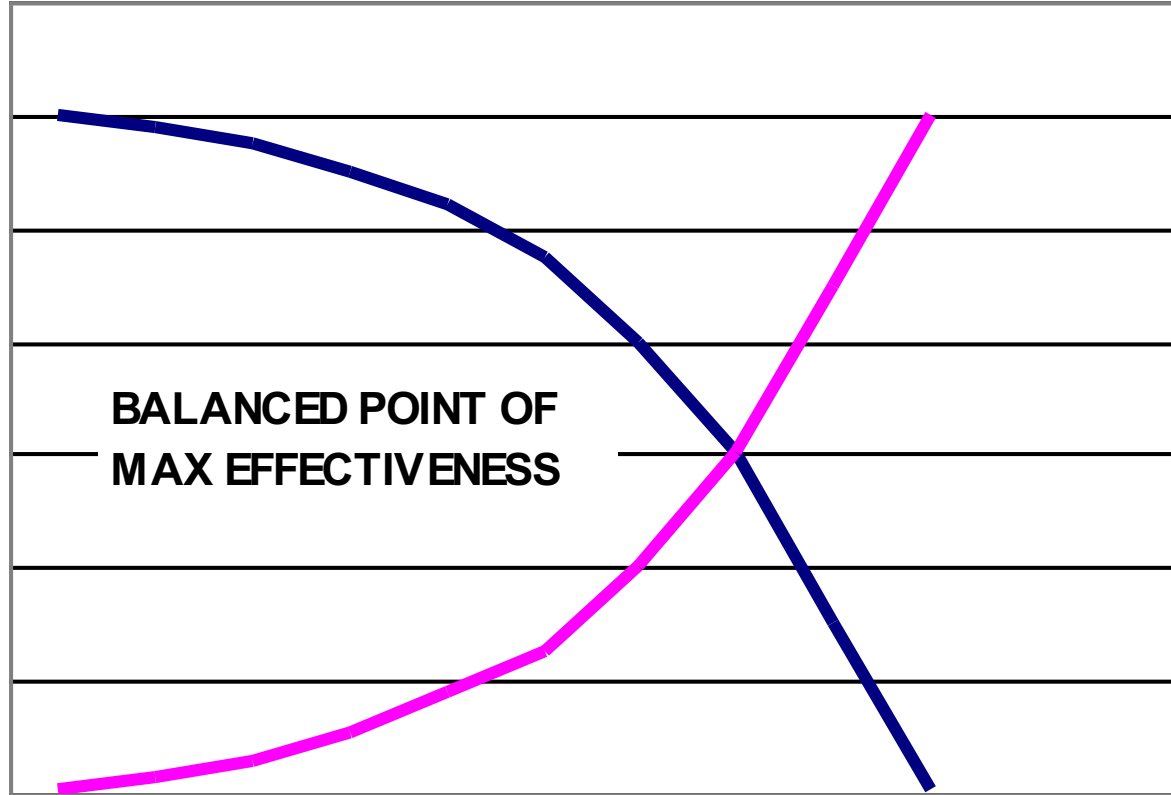

To Deal with Equity in an Uncertain Operational Environment:

- Equity rules must be built into the automation and decisions distributed
