BRAC – A real solution

- BRAC is Base Realignment and Closure
 - Periodic Rationalization of the DoD installations
 - Aggregates all base proposals into a single package for Congressional action
 - Takes the debate to a national level
- A BRAC process for NAS will
 - Eliminate "trench warfare"
 - Make manifest the benefits of downsizing



Post BRAC scenario

- No Loran C
- No VOR
- No LOC or Marker
- No RTR or BUEC
- No primary radar [ASR. ARSR, ASDE]
- 4 ACFs [no ARTCCs and few TRACONs]

Useful Definitions



- Consensus = getting <u>all</u> parties (stakeholders) to agree to something.
- Consultation = asking <u>all</u> parties (stakeholders) for their input.
- Leadership = avoiding <u>stalemate</u> by knowing the difference.
