The NextGen Challenge

- Behavior of the NAS poorly understood
- Competing constituencies (GA, Biz, Airlines)
- Complex system not amenable to "sound biting"
- One or two promising elements in the initial stages (SBS, SWIM)
- Not clear how we do the rest....

The NextGen Challenge (bottom line)

A fundamentally unplannable process



NEXTOR's Role in NextGen

- How does the system actually function?
 - Much common knowledge unsupported by data
- What changes should be made?
 - Modeling and simulation will be the only way to design NextGen
 - New models and approaches will be required
- Did the change work?
 - Performance metrics are the bedrock of NEXTOR's contribution
